The Mohawk Council of Akwesasne would like to inform the community that our offices will continue to be open to community members by appointment only.

MCA offices have had limited public access since January 3, 2022, due to the increased COVID-19 cases and presence of the Omicron variant in our community and surrounding areas.

To access any MCA public offices or health facilities, community members will be required to schedule an appointment with that program/service.

MCA will reassess the situation on <u>March 4, 2022</u> on the necessity of this measure, and will advise the community on any changes in this policy.
