### SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the supervision of the Comptroller, the incumbent assists with the financial reporting of the organization, financial planning, and budget management functions in order to safeguard Council's assets and financial reporting including the integrity of the financial information while ensuring its conformance to generally accepted accounting principles. The financial analyst will participate in strategic planning and budgeting initiatives working within the guidelines, policies and mission of the organization and will be accountable for specific projects as assigned.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Designation as a Certified Aboriginal Financial Manager (CAFM) supported by three (3) years of completed College / University with an Accounting major; or
- A Bachelors degree in Accounting plus enrolment in the CGA /CAFM stream (equivalent to Level 3 or higher) or have completed the course requirements for the CAFM. This position requires solid knowledge of accounting concepts and principles in order to complete the complex analysis required of the position.
- The position will require the completion of CAFM certification.
- 3 to 5 years of experience in a mid level finance or accounting position; work experience in government / First Nation is an asset;
- Experience with a public accounting firm: provision of audit and assurance services is considered an asset;
