SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the supervision of the Department of Infrastructure & Housing Director, the Quality Control Inspector is responsible for the Quality Assurance and Quality Control in Construction identified within the program to monitor Capital & Minor Capital Construction Projects.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Diploma (Colleges/Construction Associations), with a minimum of experience of 3 years in some type of construction.
- **OR**
- High School degree or equivalent and 5-year related experience in construction.
- Incumbent must have basic knowledge of residential and commercial construction and remodeling trades, practices, procedures, techniques, tools and equipment, and materials. He or she must have minimal ability to read blueprints. Mathematical skills and analytical skills are necessary to take and compute measurements.
- The QC Inspector will be required to have some knowledge of the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne's theories, practices and policies related to the planning, design operation, contracting, and maintenance of various construction projects upon hire. Course work through a Construction Association is an asset.

All interested applicants **MUST** submit all of the following documents:

2. Resume,
3. Copies of all relevant certificates/diplomas,
4. Copy of certificate of Indian Status or Secure Certificate of Indian Status (if applicable)
5. Three references submitted on Consent to Release Reference Check form, which can be found on the Akwesasne.ca website under Employment
6. Applicants must be able to travel to all northern portions of Akwesasne, including through the United States as necessary.

Applicants must clearly outline that they meet the qualification requirements on their resume. Native preference in hiring. A criminal record check is mandatory before start of employment.

As a requirement of employment, all applicants must have a Canadian Social Insurance number.
