**SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITY:**

Under the supervision of the Supervisor, and In Charge EMT, the Emergency Medical Technician will perform duties associated with providing rescue services and emergency medical care to the sick and injured in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations, Mountain Lake Regional protocols and AMA policies. The Emergency Medical Technician will conduct a patient assessment including but not limited to vitals. The EMT will administer basic life support treatments which are subject to periodical changes. The Emergency Medical Technician is also a mandated reporter.

- Current NYS EMT certification;
- American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR certification;
- Minimum 6 months of experience in the field of rescue and emergency medical services;
