Whereas, the uncontrolled activities of vessels using Akwesasne waterways are eroding some of its shorelines; and

Whereas, comprehensive legislation governing the conduct and activities of vessels using Akwesasne waterways is only in the initial stages of drafting; and

Whereas, the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne recognizes that the destructive nature of erosion to shorelines requires immediate control of vessels using Akwesasne waterways; and

Whereas, the most expedient approach to control vessels using Akwesasne waterways would be to amend an existing Law on an interim basis, until a specific law can be drafted and enacted;

Be It Therefore Resolved, that the following provisions shall be proposed to the community as an amendment to the Akwesasne Wildlife Conservation Law No. 19 / 85:

"No wake zone" means a waterway, designated by Mohawk Council Resolution, to be an area upon which a vessel must limit its speed so that its wake does not exceed six inches from crest to trough.

The Akwesasne Conservation Department shall clearly mark all "No Wake Zones" in a manner that is visible to all vessels using the waterway.


No person shall operate a vessel in a manner so as to create a wake exceeding six inches from crest to trough when traveling upon a "No Wake Zone".

Any person who operates a vessel in violation of this Law is guilty of an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00, or to a community service order not exceeding 100 hours or to both.
