# Current Status

- Potential delay in delivery of additional equipment required
  - Backordered due to overwhelming requests for High-Speed Internet Internationally
  - Potentially can be until 2022
  - We are working with suppliers to get in manufacturing queue to prevent major delays
- Kawehno:ke
  - Still awaiting Contribution Agreement authorization
  - Directional Drilling will begin as soon as possible
  - Pre-Registration will be announced prior to start of construction
