## **MCA REPORTS ONE NEW POSITIVE CASE OF COVID-19**

The Mohawk Council of Akwesasne's Community Health Program reports **ONE (1)** new positive case of COVID-19 in the northern portion of the community, as of July 20, 2021.

### **Current COVID-19 Statistics for the Northern Portion of Akwesasne:**

**Current Active: 1**

**Total Cases: 359**

***There have been no further COVID-19 related fatalities***

If you're experiencing any of the symptoms below within the last 72 hours without a known cause, **please stay home. Do not go to work or visit others:**

Fever >37.8 C or 100.04 F

- New onset of cough
- Worsening chronic cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Difficulty swallowing
- Decrease or loss of sense of taste or smell
- Chills
- Headaches
- Unexplained fatigue/malaise/muscle aches (myalgias)
- Nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
- Pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- Runny nose/nasal congestion without a known cause

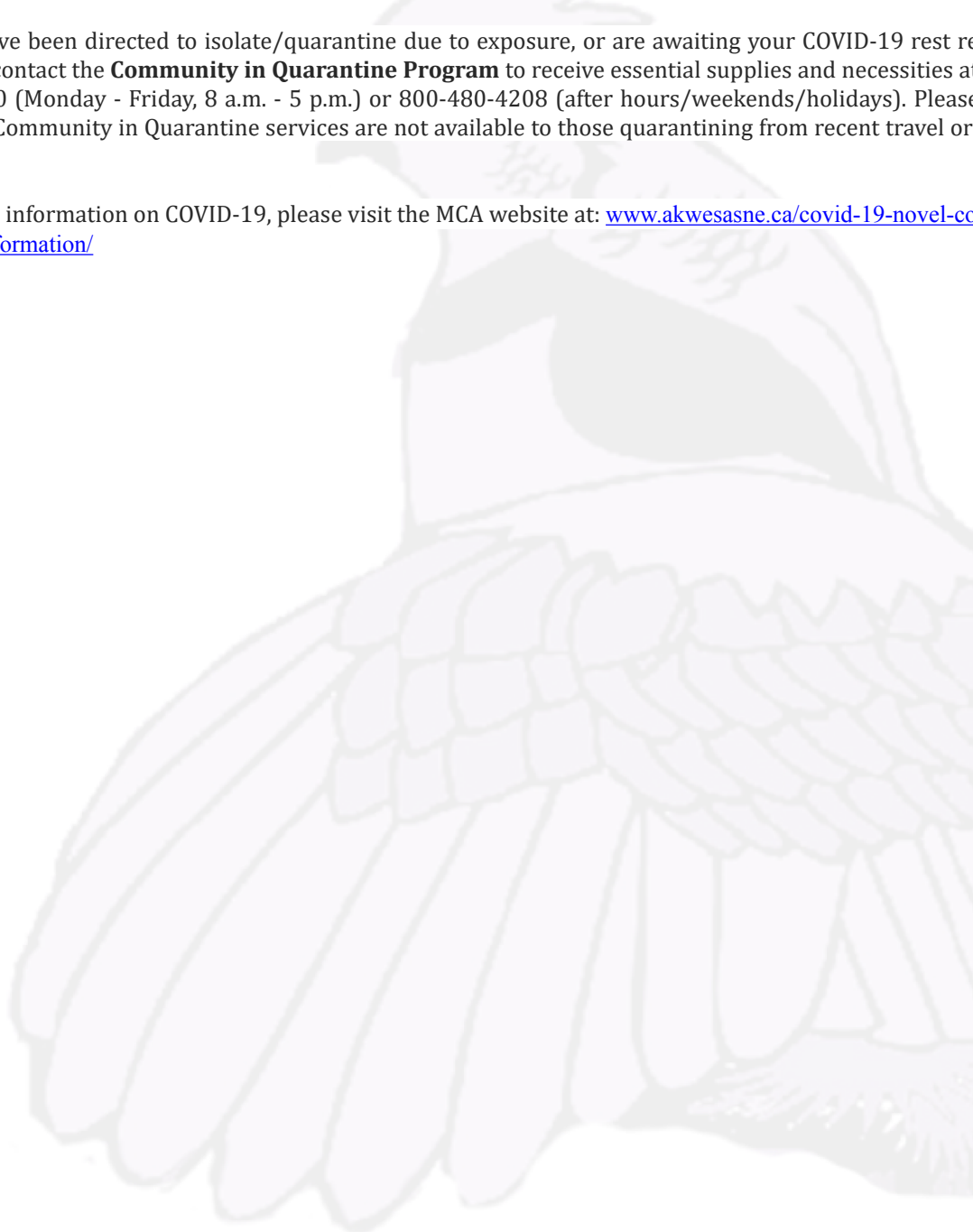


***If you've been tested for COVID-19, and are awaiting your results, please stay in isolation until you've been advised by a healthcare professional.***

Please note that the Community in Quarantine services are not available to those quarantining from recent travel or vacation.
