


MCA's Department Of Infrastructure Mission Statement

ROADS NEEDS / RECONSTRUCTION

The replacement value of the road system is significant, as roads wear out this must be reconstructed or repaired in a timely, planned manner. Failure to properly maintain and replace the system roads, culverts and equipment at the appropriate times will result in ever increasing maintenance needs.



To ensure that Akwesasne is obtaining cost effectiveness for its investment in the road system, MCA Council, through the Department of Infrastructure Housing & Environment (DIHE), monitors and maintains the condition of the present road system, and to establish a construction strategy for the future.

A substantial portion of MCA's annual budget goes towards its road system for maintenance and construction improvements.

1	Wade Lafrance Road	Tsi Snaihne (Snye)
2	Park Street / Hill Top Drive	Kanatakon (St. Regis)
3	River Road East and West completion	Tsi Snaihne (Snye)
4	Harbour Road	Kawehnoke (C.I)

The type of improvements required for the above roadways are considered full reconstruction.

Priority no. 2 – identifies required improvements for complete road reconstruction/resurfacing, including sanitary sewer, storm sewer and water service upgrades.

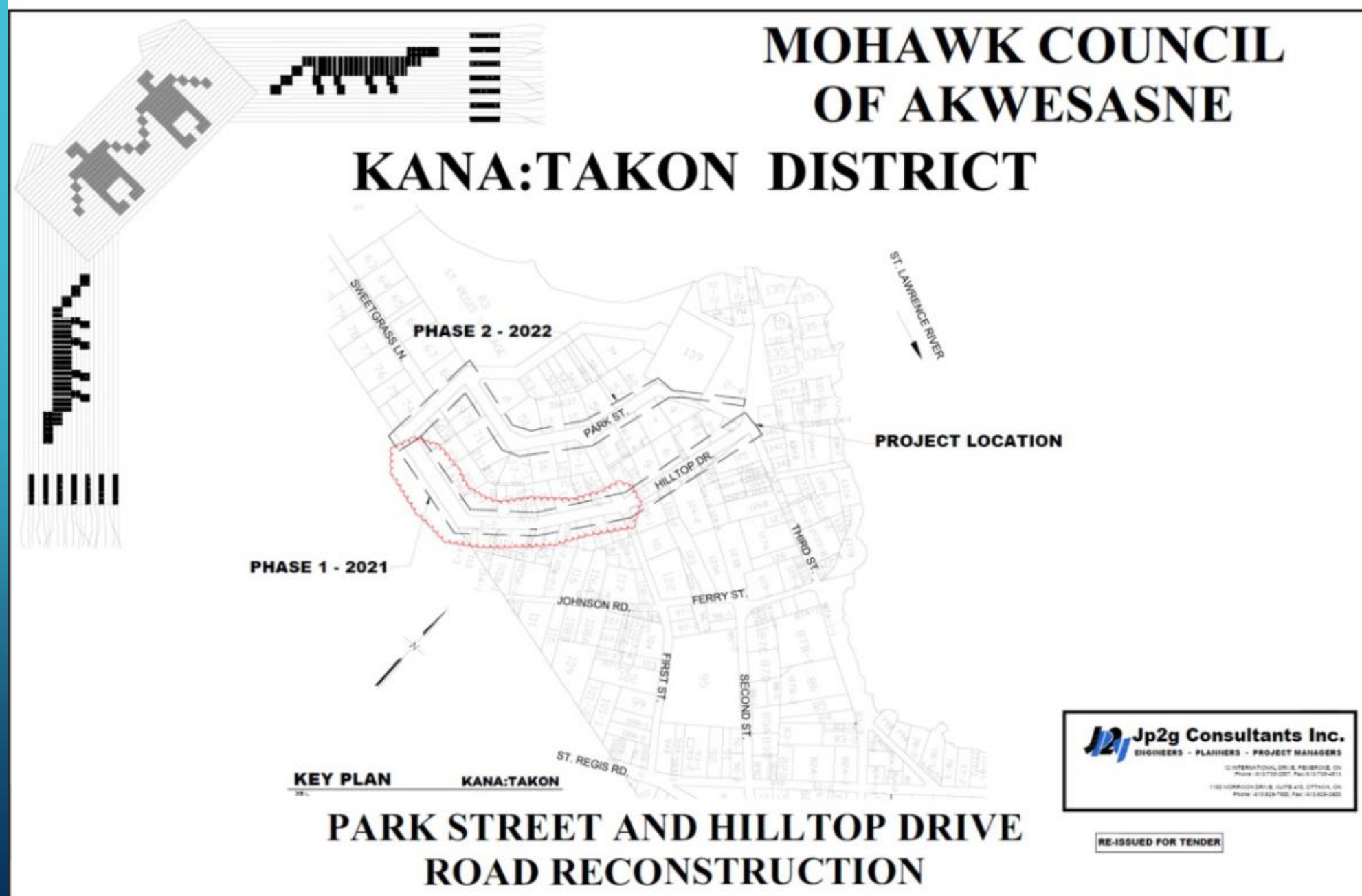

Current Condition of the Road: Park Street & Hilltop Drive

- is deemed with having one of the highest daily peak traffic counts in Akwesasne.
- It is recommended to widen the roadway to meet minimum Lane widths and will also improve traffic safety, pedestrian safety and snowplow operations in the district.
- Along this roadway, the existing water main contains asbestos concrete piping which shows signs of degradation and the Sanitary Sewer is in poor condition.

Recommendation to replace the full piping along this road and the review of the condition of the storm sewer drainage.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION – PHASE I





Lazore's Construction will be starting the Hilltop Drive Road Reconstruction Project Monday August 16 2021. For this phase we will be starting at the stop sign near Kanonhkwat'sheri:io Health facility on Hilltop Drive and ending near the stop sign at First Street. We will go approximately 360 meters or 1,180 feet.

During the road reconstruction in this area we will be replacing the old sewer pipe. Please be aware there will be temporary sewer shut off for a few hours per day.

Safety is our #1 Priority!

Hilltop Road will be closed within a 100' of work area for traffic, local traffic only. There will be a flag person and large pieces of equipment/trucks on the roadway during the construction process. We appreciate your patience and cooperation for driving other routes. Notice to the Community

From the Dept. of Infrastructure Housing & Environment:

As part of the Kanatakon Reconstruction Project Phase I, the excess surplus fill material excavated from this project will be stock-piled at the contractor's designated location and will not be released until confirmed by the consultant. It is possible that sections of the road project will need extra fill material.

During the course of this construction If extra fill material does become available for property owners, Priority of the fill distribution will be determined by the following guidelines:

- 1) Property owners who live adjacent to the site,
- 2) Other property owners in the District of Kanatakon,
- 3) Other Mohawk Council of Akwesasne projects

For those interested in the excess fill material you will need to obtain and complete the MCA Fill Release Waiver, this document can be obtained by contacting the following individuals:

Your completed Waiver must be submitted to an Environmental Assessment Officer, for review of your designated fill location on your property. You will then be placed on a list. When the material becomes available, we will confirm the number of residents who may be able to receive the material based on the quantity available.

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Waiver and Indemnification

having requested and in return for accepting fill from the River Road Reconstruction Project, agree to the following terms:

1. I/we accept the acquired fill as is and agree that I/we will not hold the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne responsible for any future problems related to that fill that may arise.
2. I/we understand that the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne makes no representations or warranty as to the quality, grade, content or usability of the fill.
3. I/we fully understand that if any adverse situation arises related to accepting, using, having, taking delivery of or otherwise possessing the fill from the River Road Reconstruction Project, regardless whether the fill is delivered by MCA or by its contractors, employees or agents, I/we accept full and sole responsibility for any such situation or matter arising.
4. I/we agree not to place or deposit any amount of the fill into wetlands, swamps or marshes or to use the fill in any way that negatively impacts or harms the environment.
5. I/we understand that depositing any amount into wetlands, swamps or marshes or using the fill in any way that negatively impacts or harms the environment may violate and result in charges under the Akwesasne Conservation Law and other applicable law.
6. I/we hereby indemnify and hold the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne, its contractors, employees and agents, harmless for any cause of action(s) or claim(s), damages, loss, injury, death, or costs including legal fees, which I/we may incur related to accepting this fill, now or in the future.
