SECTION 7 (AKWESASNE ELECTION LAW) ELIGIBILITY OF VOTERS

A person who at the time of voting must:

- a) *have attained eighteen years of age;*
- b) *be a resident in the district where they are voting;*
- c) *be a registered member of the Mohawks of Akwesasne;*
- d) *be an Onkwehonwe.*
