**SCOPE OF WORK.** The Contractor shall provide all labor, materials and perform all Work as shown on attached Drawing for the installation of four (4) dual charging stations at the A'nowara'ko:wa Arena on Kawehno:ke/Cornwall Island. The four (4) dual charging stations are previously purchased. Work shall include, but is not limited to installation of new infrastructure, concrete slab, cabinet, 1 bollard per charging station; contractor may be required to consult with Cornwall Electric for this project.

The Contractor shall be responsible for the supervision and control of all Work; the safety of the workers; and assurance that the quality of Work and character of workers conform to all applicable laws and regulations.

## **QUALIFICATIONS.** Interested parties must demonstrate:

- An understanding of and compliance with MCA Construction and Safety Guidelines
- For an Indigenous General Contractor confirmation of bonding is required
- Ability to procure and maintain "All Risk and Liability Insurance (\$2M Minimum) in accordance with General Conditions
- Be able to furnish clearance from Workers Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) or (CSST)
- Experience and Qualifications with a minimum of 3 references with the past five (5) years
