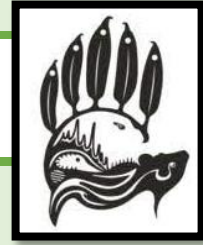




# Independent First Nations 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Youth Conference

### CONFERENCE ANNOUNCEMENT

The Independent First Nations (IFN) and our hosts Temagami First Nation, are pleased to announce that the registration process for 9<sup>th</sup> Annual IFN Youth Conference *“Back to the land, back to our Roots”* is now officially open.

### BRIEF CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

The 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Youth Conference *“Back to the Land, back to our Roots”* will provide youth with an opportunity to participate in culturally-based education and activities, with the aim of promoting generational knowledge transfer and supporting goals of long-term cultural continuity.

Youth delegates attending this year’s event can expect to listen and learn from some of Temagami’s local Knowledge Keepers and Elders, as well as from a number of invited guest speakers, presenters and facilitators. In addition, Youth delegates will have ample opportunity to participate in land-based activities and workshops (such as traditional games, cooking, crafting, fishing, harvesting etc.) as well as chances to explore the beautiful territory of Temagami First Nation.

As always, the main overarching goals of the IFN annual youth conference above all... is to empower our young people; by providing opportunities for our IFN youth to establish strong youth peer networks and providing youth with new skills, knowledge, education and abilities, that they can utilize in other aspects of their lives and carry as part of their bundle moving forward.

### CONFERENCE DATES AND LOCATION

This year’s event will take place from June 11-16, 2023, with accommodations being located at the Canadian Adventure Camp (CAC). The CAC is nestled amongst magnificent 130-foot-tall pine trees on renowned Adventure Island, surrounded by the sparkling clear waters and natural beauty of Lake Temagami.

Outside of accommodations, the majority of conference workshops and scheduled agenda activities will take place on Bear Island at the Minowaabandan-gamiing Maawanjihidiwining (MgM), also known as the Lakeview Gathering Place. Pre-arranged boat transportation will be provided daily for the Youth delegates between the CAC and MgM; and while on the Island delegates will be given opportunities to go and check out other various community buildings (i.e., Youth Centre and School Field).

## TRAVEL DATES

Delegates will begin their travel on June 11, 2023, however, for some of you traveling from further distances (e.g., Winnipeg, Thunder Bay, Sioux Lookout etc.) your travel **may** start as early as June 10, 2023. Conference organizers will arrange all travel details (flights, buses etc.) for registered delegates. Travel home will begin on the afternoon of June 16, 2023, with most of you arriving back to your destination before the end of the day.

## BEFORE COMPLETEING REGISTRATION PACKAGE

Those interested in registering **must be** from one of the IFN communities (listed below). Youth should be between the ages of **18-29 years**. Though age considerations and/or exceptions may be made on case-by-case basis.
