## MCA HOSTING TWO APPLICATION INTAKE SESSIONS FOR MRZ CARDS

The Mohawk Council of Akwesasne would like to invite the community to either of two application intake sessions for Canada's Machine Readable Zone (MRZ) Certificate of Indian Status cards.

The MRZ cards help to simplify the border crossing process for First Nations individuals. As a secure and scan-able document, it can be used at ports of entry (POE) between Canada and the United States, speeding up wait times and processing times.
