FNCFS HOME REPAIR PROGRAM

PROJECT START DATE: JUNE 2025
PROJECT END DATE: MARCH 2026

Description of Program:

The First Nations Child and Family Services (FNCFS) Home Repair Program will be made available to community members who have children under 18 years in their home and require home repairs such as mold remediation, roof repair, replace siding or furnace, add insulation, HRV installation, etc.

The MCA Department of Infrastructure, Housing and Environment's (DIHE) Housing Sector will administer this project for homes that require repair, not cosmetic renovations. The maximum amount available is \$15,000 per civic address.

Criteria:

- *Applicant must be the head of household.*
- *Must be for a primary residence.*
- *Must be residing in MCA jurisdiction in the northern portion of Akwesasne.*
- *Must be in good standing with the DIHE Housing Sector.*
- *Must provide proof of income.*
- *Pay any overages over the \$15,000.*
- *Applications are being taken the first two weeks of June.*

Application Deadline: June 13, 2025

The goal of the FNCFS Home Repair Fund is to provide required home repairs for our homes with children to make their home as comfortable as possible. The goal of the FNCFS Home Repair Fund is to provide assistance for low-income families to ensure they have necessities to live comfortably such as heat, electricity, water, no mold issues and safety in their homes. **Priority will be given to those households that have applied in the past and have not received any assistance.**
