## CALL OUT FOR AKWESASNE REVIEW COMMISSION MEMBERS

The Mohawk Council of Akwasasne is currently seeking applicants to fill one (1) vacant seat on the Akwasasne Review Commission (ARC) representing the District of Kana:takon for a three (3)-year term. Applications are also being accepted for a pool of alternate members.

The Akwasasne Review Commission was established as an independent body to hold every Justice and every member of a Decision-Making Body accountable to the community by enabling their conduct to be examined fairly and impartially pursuant to the Charter. The Akwasasne Review Commission shall have exclusive responsibility to receive, investigate and decide upon a Complaint made in respect of the conduct of every Justice and every member of a Decision-Making Body.

To qualify for an appointment to the Akwasasne Review Commission, a candidate must:

- a) be a Member of Mohawks of Akwasasne;
- b) have attained the age of thirty-five (35) years of age;
- c) have been a in the territory of a First Nation for a least ten (10) years and within the past fifteen (15) years;
- d) have good character, credibility and reputation in the Akwasasne community;
- e) have knowledge of Mohawk cultures and traditions;
- f) have adequate education and relevant work or life experience, and possess an interest in the settling of disputes;
- g) not be an elected member of Council or the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribal Council, an employee of the Akwasasne Justice Department;
- h) Not be a Tsionkweta Teshakowennakhwa (Duty Counsel) or Raontiwenakara:tats (Prosecutor);
- i) never have been convicted of an offense under the Akwasasne Banishment Law, the Akwasasne Drug Law, an indictable offense in Canada or a felony in the United States;
- j) not have been convicted of an offense under Akwasasne Law, a summary conviction offense in Canada, or a misdemeanor in the United States in the past five (5) years;
- k) produce a valid certificate from the Canadian Police Information Centre;
- l) never have been previously removed from the Akwasasne Review Commission; and
- m) be considered “In Good Standing” with the Mohawk Council of Akwasasne Good Standing Policy.

The call out is open until **June 15, 2026 at 4:00 p.m.**
