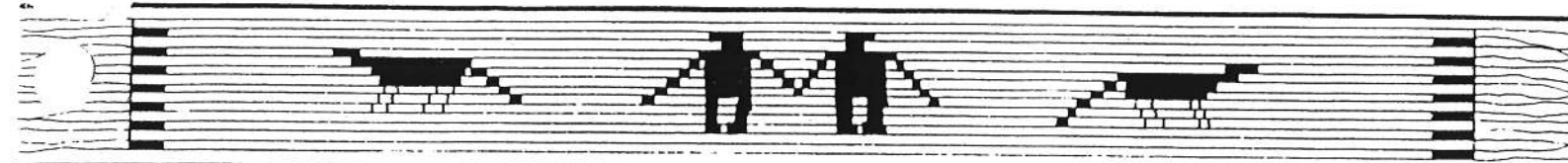

RECREATION MINIMUM BY-LAW

BY-LAW NO.

Being a By-Law to authorize the carrying on of a Community Recreation Program within the meaning of the regulation under the Ministry of Tourism and Recreation Act 1982.

1. The Mohawk Council of Akwesasne enacts as follows:

- A) Pursuant to the needs of Akwesasne, and in consultation with the Ministry of Tourism and Recreation Act, 1982, a Community Recreation Program is hereby established for the residents of Akwesasne.
- B) The said Community Program of Recreation shall be directed, managed and controlled on behalf of the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne by a committee known as the Directors of Recreation Committees for Akwesasne.

2. The committee shall be appointed annually by the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne as follows:

- A) Three (3) members of the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne and
- B) Six (6) members of the community of Akwesasne.

3. In carrying out the provisions of this by-law, the committee shall at all times be the representative of the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne and while acting bona fide within the limits of the authority of this by-law neither the committee nor any member thereof shall incur any liability by reason of anything done or left undone by the committee.

Provided however, that nothing in this paragraph contained shall authorize or empower the committee to incur any debt, liabilities or obligations for which the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne shall become liable without having previously obtained the consent of the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne through Purchase Order or Mohawk Council Resolution.

4. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its final passing with Mohawk Council Resolution attached.
