TENDER FOR CONTRACT 25-1028A – BLOCK 97 SEWAGE PUMPING STATION UPGRADES

Tenders, sealed in envelopes and clearly marked as to the contents, will be received by Leslie Papineau, Director, Mohawk Council of Akwesasne Department of Infrastructure and Housing, Administration Building No. 3, Cornwall Island, Ontario K6H 0G5, Telephone (613) 936-1548, until:

11:00 a.m., Local Time, October 16th, 2025

for the construction of the works described below.

On the same day, commencing at 11:05 a.m. local time, the tenders will be opened and read publicly at the Cornwall Island Administration Office #3 on Cornwall Island.

Project description – The main objective of this project is to upgrade the existing pumping station to replace the failing pumping station appurtenances, integrate the pumping station into the MCA's SCADA system, increase the capacity of the pumping station for current and future flow conditions, and to operate the pumps via variable frequency drives such that the MCA will have the ability to control the pump rate as needed, based on the operational conditions at the RBC.

Mandatory Job Showing is scheduled for October 7th, 2025 at 10:30am at the Block 97 Pumping Station at 30 Kawehnoke Apartment Road.

Tenders must be accompanied by a tender deposit payable to the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne as follows:

- for First Nations contractors in the form of a certified cheque, bank draft or money order in the amount of 10% of the total tender price to a maximum of \$20,000
- for all other contractors as a Bid Bond for an amount equal to 10% of the total tender price.

Evaluation of all tenders will follow the Tendering Policy of the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne, which is intended to increase the participation of local and other Aboriginal businesses in construction and materials supply contracting.

Tenders are subject to a formal contract being prepared and executed. The Council reserves the right to reject any or all tenders and the lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted.
