The Story of Our Names:

The name "Toronto" is derived from the Kanyen'kéha (Mohawk) word "Tkaronto" which translates to "where there are trees standing in the water."

"Ontario" is from the Kanyen'kéha (Mohawk) word Oniatari:io (or Kanadario). It translates to "beautiful lake" or "sparkling water."

The name "Canada" originates from the Kanyen'kéha (Mohawk) word Kaná:ta, which means "town" or "village."
